



Fact Sheet

Overview:

Wilderness at the Smokies, the Smoky Mountain's Largest Waterpark Resort is situated in close proximity to the Great Smoky Mountain National Park, the most visited national park in the country.

The mountain modern resort features 234 Stone Hill guest rooms; 472 River Lodge suites; 20 Villas; six treehouse cabins; eight five-bedroom entertainment cabins; and 14 four-bedroom cabins; an indoor waterpark; two seasonal outdoor waterparks; an Adventure Forest family activity center; a variety of dining and shopping options; a 36-hole championship golf course adjacent to the resort; and more than 200,000 square feet of meeting and convention space at the Sevierville Convention Center which adjacent to Stone Hill Lodge.

Complimentary shuttles transport guests between Stone Hill Lodge and River Lodge making it easy for families to relax and have fun. During the summer months, shuttles also run to/from Soaky Mountain Waterpark, our sister property, located across the street from our resort.

As a year-round waterpark vacation destination, Wilderness at the Smokies delivers an exciting lodging and entertainment option for families vacationing in the Pigeon Forge/ Gatlinburg/ Sevierville region.

Location:

The resort is located just minutes from Interstate 40 at 1424 Old Knoxville Hwy, Sevierville, TN 37876. It is 30 minutes from Knoxville; two hours from Chattanooga; and under four hours from Atlanta.

Wilderness at the Smokies Waterpark Facts:

Wilderness at the Smokies is home to three waterparks. The Wild WaterDome Indoor Waterpark at River Lodge, Lake Wilderness Outdoor Waterpark at River Lodge and Salamander Spring Outdoor Waterpark at Stone Hill Lodge.

Play It Safe:

The resort has more than 150 lifeguards trained and certified through Ellis & Associates, the industry leader in aquatic safety, oversee the safety operations and regulations for Wilderness at the Smokies. The resort also has a limited number of Coastguard certified lifejackets available for guest use.

The Wild WaterDome Indoor Waterpark at River Lodge is 106,000 square feet and features a Foil Tec roof that allows the sun to permeate through it and guests to tan indoors (bring your sunscreen!). Highlights include:

- **Kaleidoscope Kavern Lazy River**, features an immersive tunnel where the natural beauty of the Smoky Mountains surrounds your senses as you float down the river surrounded by kaleidoscope lighting and captivating sounds
- **Ridge Runner Water Coaster**, this three-story coaster features three steep drops, uphill adrenaline-boosting blasts and high speeds with the Revere Aqualucent tubes that create colorful, spellbinding patterns and special effects
- **Magnolia Grove Indoor/Outdoor Hot Spa**, features 25 feet of benches inside and 45 feet of benches outside for guests to relax on while soaking in 101 degree water with plenty of jets.
- **Lookout Lagoon**, a rooftop pool with glass edge, the pool area also features rooftop cabanas, an entertainment area and a bar/eatery
- **Storm Chaser Thrill Ride**, a four-person tube slide featuring a 55-foot plummet down a dark tunnel ride into a swirling funnel of water with night illumination; 48" height requirement
- **Trail Twister Tube Slides**, two swirling, adrenaline-filled one- and two-person tube slides; 42" height requirement with an adult, 48" height requirement to ride alone
- **Runaway Canyon**, a four-person tube slide that careens 450 feet through water curtains, tunnels, turns and loops; 42" height requirement with an adult, 48" height requirement to ride alone
- **Smokies Surf Rider**, a simulated body-surfing experience, the only of its kind in the region, powered by more than 50,000 gallons of water; 42" height requirement
- **The Great Wave**, a 10,700 square-foot wave pool capable of generating waves up to five feet tall
- **Washout Mountain**, a multi-level play structure with 750-gallon bucket dump, 50 play-and-spray features, body and kiddie slides
- **Flying Squirrel**, a zero-depth entry toddler area with two mini-slides and swing tree
- **Cabana Shores**, overlooking the Great Wave this area features four cabanas with private seating, and a waitstaff to assist you with your food and beverage needs

Lake Wilderness Outdoor Waterpark at River Lodge spans 96,000 square-feet. It is open for the summer season. Highlights include:

- **The Wall**, a one- or two-person tube waterslide featuring dark twists and steep drops before careening up a 35-foot wall; 48" height requirement and combined rider 100 lb. weight requirement
- **Cyclone Racer**, a four-lane, high-speed, mat waterslide from 50 foot-high racing tower; 42" height requirement
- **The Wild Vortex**, a 66 foot-tall and near-vertical, translucent, looping body waterslide; riders stand in a trap door release capsule and then free fall drop 39-feet generating maximum g-force (2.5 g in less than two seconds) before reaching an inclined loop; 48" height requirement and 100 lb. weight requirement
- **Cataloochee Creek Adventure River**, this attraction spans more than 750 feet around the entire outdoor waterpark
- **Washout Wilderness Rapids**, a 12,000 square-foot wave pool capable of generating waves up to five feet tall

- **Treehouse Springs**, a zero-depth entry wading pool featuring sprinklers, bubblers, geyser jets, waterfall splashes, dumping buckets, and interactive antiquities galore; there is also a tree-house tower with three slides
- **Private Poolside Cabanas**, 14 cabanas available to rent, each equipped with flat screen TVs, ceiling fans, luxury outdoor furniture, poolside cabana service, lush towels and cool misters
- **Cabana Forest**, 9 VIP Climate Controlled, Cabin-Style Cabanas available to rent, each equipped with a flat-screen TV, ceiling fan, luxury-comfort furniture, air-conditioning, refrigerator and lush towels and poolside beverage and menu service

Salamander Springs Outdoor Waterpark at Stone Hill Lodge encompasses 24,000 square-feet. It is also open for the summer season. Highlights include:

- **The Timber Rattler**, one of the longest tube slides in Tenn., at 207 feet long; 42" height requirement with an adult, 48" height requirement to ride alone
- **The River Otter**, a curvy body slide running 180 feet in length; 42" height requirement.
- **Lunker's Landing**, a four-level play structure with three water slides, 750-gallon tipping bucket and 50+ play-and-spray water activities
- **Catfish Corral**, an activity pool with basketball hoops, balance courses and more
- **Minnow Marsh**, a zero-depth entry play area with tot swings

Adventure Forest at River Lodge

- **Adventure Forest Mega Arcade**, a family-friendly arcade with more than 100 arcade games and prize redemption area
- **Howlin' Hound Dog Alley**, a miniature bowling alley with six full lanes
- **Moonshine Run**, a nine-hole, black-light miniature golf course
- **Frog Hopper**, a spring ride
- **Copperhead Lazer Maze**
- **Mount Wild**, a 23-foot-tall indoor rock climbing wall
- **Fury in the Forest**, a multi-level laser tag arena
- **Tree Top Towers**, a three-story ropes course with cargo nets, balance beams and mid-air lily pads
- **XD Adventure Theater**, a state-of-the-art laser blasting game combined with a rollercoaster feel where you can ride, blast and compete your way into other dimensions
- **Rocky Top Glider**, a cloud coaster

Other Onsite Attractions:

- **Polka Dot Pots**, a paint your own pottery located in River Lodge

Nearby Off-Site Attractions

- **Soaky Mountain Waterpark**, a 50-acre outdoor waterpark, is located across the street from Wilderness at the Smokies. It is open May – September and is owned by our parent company Wilderness Resorts and Waterparks.
 - Highlights include the Avalaunch and The Edge water coasters; Soaky Surge, a 35,000 sq. ft. wave pool; Black Bear Rapids, an adventure river; and more!
 - Wilderness at the Smokies guests can get free admission to Soaky Mountain during certain weeks of year and discounted admission the remaining season.

- **The Sevierville Golf Club** is next door to River Lodge. It features two 18-hole championship courses: The Highlands Course and The River Course. For tee times call 865.429.4223 or visit SeviervilleGolfClub.com

Food and Beverage options include:

- **Camp Social**, a 5,000-square-foot family-friendly food hall open for breakfast and dinner. It features a **Burger Bar; Tacolicious; Lily's Campsite Pizza Bakery;** and **Coffee Canteen**
- **Firefly Bar and Grill**, located in the River Lodge lobby, it features delicious salads, hearty burgers and other entrees such as a Peach Bourbon Glazed Porterhouse Pork Chop or a Honey Ginger Cedar Salmon Fillet
- **Hidden Trail Bar and Grill**, located in Stone Hill Lodge, it features fantastic appetizers, like deep fried Wisconsin Cheese Curds and Fried Green Tomatoes; a variety of fresh salads, burgers and wraps; and delicious Naan Bread Pizzas
- **Billy Jacks Snack Shack** located in the Adventure Forest, it serves hot sandwiches, burgers, pizza and homemade funnel cakes with a variety of toppings
- **The Deli** located in the River Lodge lobby, it serves up Starbucks® coffee drinks and breakfast, lunch or dinner deli subs as well as bagels, muffins and bakery items
- **Candy Cabin** located near Camp Social, it serves up all sorts of heavenly delights including fudge, truffles, chocolate covered pretzels and more
- **Yukon Yogurt** located near Camp Social, it features 15 flavors of frozen yogurt and sorbet with an assortment of toppings
- **Grizzly's Grill**, a snack bar located within the Wild WaterDome Indoor Waterpark, it serves up pizza, burgers, chicken tenders and more family favorites
- **Molly's Shake Shoppe**, located within the Wild WaterDome Indoor Waterpark, it serves up amazing ice cream mixed in a variety of crazy flavors and toppings, like the Cookie Monster or the Berried Treasure of Wake 'N Shake
- **Coyote Cove**, a snack bar located adjacent to Salamander Springs Outdoor Waterpark
- **Bluegill's Cove**, a snack bar located in Lake Wilderness outdoor waterpark
