**Wilderness at the Smokies Offers a variety of Delectable Restaurants and Eateries**

Sevierville, Tenn. –Wilderness at the Smokies, home to Tennessee’s largest indoor waterpark and a premier destination in the Great Smoky Mountain region, offers a wide variety of delectable restaurants and eateries for guests as well as area tourists and residents to enjoy and experience.

**Firefly Bar and Grill**, located in the River Lodge lobby, is open daily to the public and resort guests. Its menu features delicious salads, hearty burgers and other entrees such as a Peach Bourbon Glazed Porterhouse Pork Chop or a Honey Ginger Cedar Salmon Fillet.

**Hidden Trail Bar and Grill**, whose hours vary and are listed in the Wilderness Express, is conveniently located in Stone Hill Lodge, behind the front desk. It serves up fantastic appetizers, like deep fried Wisconsin Cheese Curds and Fried Green Tomatoes; a variety of fresh salads, burgers and wraps; and delicious Naan Bread Pizzas. The restaurant also has a thoughtful kids’ menu and decadent Chocolate Lava Cake for dessert, which will enthrall any chocolate enthusiast! If you’re a Starbucks’ devotee you will be pleased to find a dedicated Starbucks station.

Located at River Lodge overlooking the Wild WaterDome indoor waterpark, **Camp Social** is a 5,000-square-foot family-friendly food hall open for breakfast, lunch and dinner. It features a **Burger Bar**, which serves up some of the tastiest certified angus beef hamburgers, foot-long hotdogs and seasoned fries; **Tacolicious**, which

serves up delicious tacos, nachos, tacos bowls and its famous walking taco; **Lily's Campsite Pizza Bakery** which offers giants slices as well as whole pizzas, breadsticks and large soft pretzels; and **Coffee Canteen** which serves locally-sourced Mahalo coffee, teas, smoothies and pastries. Camp Social also offers a hearty breakfast buffet (daily in summer and on select days the rest of the year) which features everything from scrambled eggs to omelets and more!

Other indoor food options available at the resort include: **Swimm'n Chick'n** located in the Adventure Forest, which features a menu centered around hand-crafted gourmet chicken tenders; **The Deli** in the River Lodge lobby, which serves up Starbucks® coffee drinks and breakfast, lunch or dinner deli subs as well as bagels, muffins and bakery items; **Candy Cabin** located near Camp Social, which serves up all sorts of heavenly delights including fudge, truffles, chocolate covered pretzels and more; and **Yukon Yogurt** also located near Camp Social, which offers 9 flavors of frozen yogurt and sorbet with an assortment of toppings.

Guests utilizing the resort's Wild WaterDome indoor waterpark can take a break from the action to eat at **Grizzly's Grill**, a snack bar within the waterpark that serves up pizza, burgers, chicken tenders and more family favorites; and then enjoy dessert at **Molly's Shake Shoppe**, which serves up amazing ice cream mixed in a variety of crazy flavors and toppings, like the Cookie Monster, Berried Treasure or Wake 'N Shake.

**Peak Rooftop Bar** will not only quench your thirst with cocktails but it also serves a delicious menu including grilled chicken skewers, roasted garlic hummus, jumbo pretzels, tuna poke nachos, a variety of delicious flatbreads and healthy salads. The Peak also offers live entertainment (weather permitting) on Friday and Saturday nights, allowing patrons to relax and unwind in a fantastic setting.

Finally, during the summer months guests utilizing our outdoor waterparks can enjoy **Coyote Cove** snack bar located adjacent to Salamander Springs outdoor waterpark and **Bluegill's Cove** snack bar located in Lake Wilderness outdoor waterpark.

Wilderness at the Smokies is the Smoky Mountain region's largest waterpark resort and family entertainment center. It is located in Sevierville, TN, and is situated in the foothills of the Great Smoky Mountains, whose famous national park is the most popular in the United States welcoming over 11 million visitors a year.

The resort features 234 Stone Hill guest rooms; 472 River Lodge suites; 20 Villas; six treehouse cabins; eight five-bedroom entertainment cabins; 14 four-bedroom cabins; an 84-degree, year-round indoor waterpark; two seasonal outdoor waterparks; an indoor family entertainment center; a variety of dining and shopping options; a 36-hole championship golf course adjacent to the resort; and more than 200,000 square feet of meeting and convention space adjacent to Stone Hill Lodge.

It is owned by Wilderness Resort and Waterparks, a Wisconsin Dells, Wisconsin-based hotel and hospitality development and management company which also operates Soaky Mountain Waterpark across the street from the resort as well Wilderness Resort, Glacier Canyon Lodge, Wilderness on the Lake and Sundara Spa all in Wisconsin Dells.
